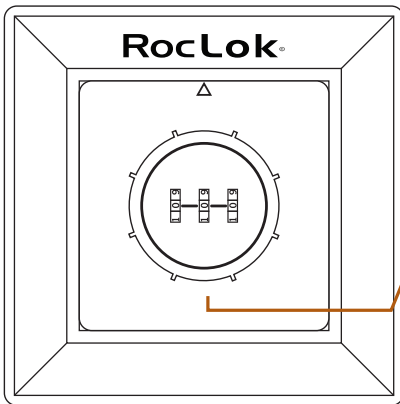


CARING FOR YOUR ROCLOK HIDE A KEY:

*Metal and the outdoors don't always play well together. Even though the lock we use is rated for use outside we suggest checking in on your RocLok at least once every couple of months to make sure it is always in good working order. Lubricating the lock periodically with a silicone based oil will keep the lock from rusting and make sure all the moving parts will work for you. **Do not use WD-40 to lubricate your RocLok Hide a Key!** WD-40 is a great product for cleaning metal NOT lubricating it. The use of WD-40 will remove needed grease from the lock and freeze the moving parts in place. You should be able to find a good silicone based oil at any hardware shop.*

Depending on the moisture level of your soil, you may notice that the lid on your RocLok Hide a Key will become tight and may be difficult to remove. If this happens the following steps will help you remove the lid without causing damage to your RocLok:



- 1. Enter your 3 digit code and with the logo legible, rotate the lock to the left (or counterclockwise)**
- 2. Place the claw-side of a hammer underneath the lock on the side opposite the arrow and logo and gently lift upward**

Once the lid is safely removed from your RocLok taking sandpaper to the edges of the lid will decrease the friction, repeat as necessary.
